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## Nursery & Reception Classes in September

## School Uniform for September.

This is a reminder about our school uniform, which you should bear in mind when buying clothing for September.

Children should wear a school sweatshirt or cardigan, dark grey trousers/skirt and a white polo or shirt. If the weather is hot, blue checked summer dresses are acceptable and boys may wear grey/black shorts.

**Sportswear, jogging bottoms and tracksuit trousers are not uniform and should only be worn for outdoor P.E. lessons.**

The school outdoor P.E. kit for Years 3 to 6 is a grey sweatshirt (without a hood) and black jogging trousers (sweatshirts & joggers should not have brand logos or designs on them).

All pupils need an indoor P.E. kit, which is a white T shirt, black shorts and black pumps.

Please use only book bags & drawstring PE bags, so that all items fit in school lockers to keep classrooms and corridors tidy.
