Our R.E. Topic this half term is 'The Ten Commandments'. Through this topic your child will have the opportunity to:

- Know that God loves us and calls us into a relationship with him;
- Know that God gave Moses the Ten Commandments on Mount Sinai because he loves us;
- Understand that the Ten Commandments are a gift from God to help us;
- Understand how we can show our love for God by keeping his commandments
- Know that God sent his Son Jesus into the world because he loves us.

Know and appreciate the purpose of the Ten Commandments

We will read the Ten Commandments. We will discuss the meaning of them and the importance of the Commandments in our lives today.

We will show our understanding of the Commandments through drama.

The children will realise that we enter into a covenant with God by following the Commandments.

The Ten Commandments



Reflect on the birth of Jesus.

We will reflect on how the birth of Jesus at Christmas is a sign of God's love for us.

We will reflect on ways we can deepen our relationship with God during the Christmas period. The children will plan and perform their own liturgy to show their understanding of how the incarnation shows God loves us all.

We will create sense poems as if we were in the stable in Bethlehem.

Understand that the Commandments are a gift from God to help us

The children will be transported to the future and be given the opportunity to reflect on how the world might be if the Commandments were abolished or altered. They will use their knowledge and understanding of the Commandments to respond in role to problems sent to the High Council Advisory Service of Elysium, the imaginary future planet. We will also create rules for our own families to follow here and now based on the Commandments.
