Our R.E. Topic this half term is 'Inspirational People'.

Through this topic your child will have the opportunity to:

- know the conditions for following Jesus; [Mk. 12:29-30; Matt. 18:22; Lk. 9:23-26]
- know how Jesus described a true disciple; [Lk. 6:27-38 & 46-49; Matt. 25:35-40]
- know that in order to gain eternal life we have to respond to the graces God has given to us;
- know the story of a person who showed great love for others, e.g. Bakhita;
- know the story of a person who had a special love for those rejected by society; Damien;
- know the story of person who was an inspiration for young people e.g. Dominic Savio; Maria Goretti;
- identify people today who are an inspiration in their service of others  
They will have the chance to:
  - take time to reflect on our commitment to following Jesus;
  - reflect on how we can serve others at home, school, locally, globally;
  - know that Lent is a time when we can make small sacrifices to show our love for God and for others.

The children will be encouraged to think about what qualities a person has to have, in order to be thought of as an inspirational person. They will look at these qualities and think about why they are admirable and how they can aim to possess these same qualities.
