## Creation and Stewardship



Our R.E. Topic this term combines learning from The Way, The Truth and The Life scheme of work as well as the Year 5 CAFOD unit.

Through this topic your child will have the opportunity to:

- Know that for a long time people have asked questions about creation and reflect on some responses to these questions.
- Know about the story of Creation in the Bible and reflect on the importance of this.
- Know about the story of the Fall and think about how it helps us to understand suffering in the world.
- Understand that God calls us to care for creation and be aware of our roles and responsibilities as Stewards of Creation.
- Know about some of God's great helpers and reflect on what we can learn from them.
- Be aware of God's great gifts to us and reflect on the importance of our own gifts.

### God the Creator

*We believe God is 'Creator of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.'*

We will learn about the story of Creation in the Bible. Pupils will learn how to locate this in the Bible and will become familiar with the verses which describe God creating the world over seven days.

### Stewards of the Earth

*God has given us a wonderful world, the gift of His creation. He wants us to be stewards of this creation.*

We will learn how we are called to use our God-given gifts and talents to care for the whole world and other people. We will learn that we only have one earth and must care for it.

### The Fall

*We know that in our world things are not always good and happy. In Genesis, the writer wants to explain how these things can happen in a world that God created as good.*

We will learn about the story of The Fall to help us understand how, through the actions of human beings, good things can go wrong.

### God's Great Helpers

*When Jesus was on earth, he not only taught people, he went about helping those in need: curing the sick, restoring sight to the blind and eating with sinners.*

We will learn about lives and actions of St. Martin de Porres and St. Vincent de Paul and think about what we can learn from them.
