- Know that Jesus' miracles reflected the beginning of the Kingdom and show us what God is like.

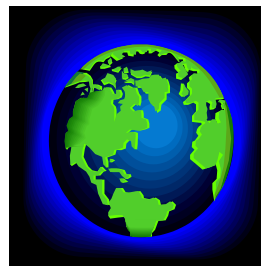
We will:

The Kingdom of God

Reflect on what the Kingdom of God is like

We will compare an earthly kingdom to that of The Kingdom of God. We will reflect on how the parables tell us what the Kingdom is like. We will also look for evidence in the local press of people following the values of God's Kingdom in today's society.

Reflect on the importance of responding to the invitation to the Kingdom

We will focus on how we are invited to be members of God's Kingdom through the sacraments of Baptism, The Eucharist, Reconciliation and Confirmation.

Know that Jesus' miracles reflected the beginning of the Kingdom and show us what God is like

We will be looking at a variety of Miracles from The Bible and categorising them into 'power over nature/death/disease'. We will reflect on how this tells us what God is like.

Know that everyone is called to enter the Kingdom and reflect on our response

Using the parable of The Lost Sheep (Luke 15: 4-6) as inspiration we will be writing letters to the public to inform them that the Kingdom of God is for everyone.

Reflect on words and deeds necessary to show commitment to the Kingdom

The children will reflect on how the values of The Kingdom can be put into practice in words and deeds.
