

## Year 2 Autumn (1)

Our R.E. Topic this half term is 'The Chosen People and Judaism'.

Through this topic your child will have the opportunity to:

- Know we are chosen and gifted by God and we thank God for choosing us by helping others;
- Know why God chose Abraham and that he trusted in God to guide him;
- Reflect on how we trust God;
- Know that God chose Moses to help his people and that we are also chosen to help others;
- Understand that Daniel had to be brave and have faith because he was chosen.
- The children will learn about the faith of Judaism and how people who celebrate the Jewish faith celebrate Shabbat.

# The Chosen People

*Jesus said 'Serve one another with the gifts each of you received' Peter 4:10*

Know that we are chosen by God and we thank God by helping others.

The children will talk about the gifts given to each one of them and reflect on being chosen by God.

*"I have called you by your name - you are mine!"*

Know that God chose Moses to help his people and we are also chosen to help others.

The children will act out the story of Moses and find out about God's plan for Moses. They will also write a class prayer to celebrate God's love for them.



Know why God chose Abraham and Abraham trusted God to guide him.

We will read the story of Abraham and we will reflect on how God guided Abraham in a special way.

Understand that Daniel had to be brave and have faith because he was chosen.

The children will listen to and discuss the story 'Daniel and The Lion's Den'. Through this story they will learn about right and wrong choices and think about the choices that they have made.
