Our R.E. Topic this half term is 'People of Other Faiths'. Through this topic your child will have the opportunity to:

- Know that we live in a country where people have different cultures.
- Reflect on different beliefs in our country.
- Reflect on other religions.
- Reflect on similarities and differences between Christianity and other religions.
- Know what the Catholic Church teaches about our relations with other faiths.
- Know that Christianity comes from Judaism.

People of Other Faiths

Know that we live in a country where people have different cultures.

Reflect on different beliefs in our country.

We will be looking at how we are a diverse nation of people. The children will have the opportunity to research their own family descent and use this to celebrate the diversity in our class and nation as a whole. We will be taking a snapshot view at the key facts about other world faiths and the children will be creating glossary's of key words linked to them.



Know what the Catholic Church teaches about our relations with other faiths.

We will be looking at the words of Jesus to see how He wants us to react to people of other faiths. "*Love one another as I have loved you*". The children will be role playing situations as Sr. Magdeleine and people from other faiths to enhance and deepen their knowledge of Christians relations with people from other faiths.

Reflect on similarities and differences between Christianity and other religions.

The children will be identifying key similarities and differences between Christianity and other World Religions. They will be looking around school to do an audit of what makes us a 'Christian School' and also researching signs, symbols and traditions that other religions have to show their faith.

Know that Christianity comes from Judaism.

The children will be finding out how Christianity comes from the religion of Judaism. They will research the key similarities and also use their prior work from the topic to create an information leaflet about it.
